The Guitar Twang SurveyLockdown 2020 Edition – *TWANG-20*

The Basic Idea

This is a survey of guitars with regard to their twanginess. The starting plan is to just list or chart guitars with their twanginess "score", however sorting and categorizing are likely to follow. Obvious variations to a model/type, including of course pickups, set-up, amps and their settings, and even tone control settings, are expected, and this may cause the list to break-out with more detail. (One would generally think fairly wide-open (high) tone would be used for twangy playing, so guitar pots will probably be full up, and the amp controls somewhere sensible; to each their own though.)

Here are some other notes:

- 1. Twanginess will be rated on a scale from anything greater than 0.0 to less than 10.0.
- 2. At a minimum, the inputs required are a guitars with their (rather subjective) nominal twanginess values, and comments as desired. Other numerical or qualitative parameters may get considered as things evolve.
- 3. The resulting twanginess values may change as data is gathered, keeping things relative.
- 4. Acoustic guitars could make it into the list, though they might get their own list.

A Starting Chart
